## **Vote for Caffrey, Benvenuto**

When Jeffrey Grayzel sat on the Morris Township Committee as a minority Democrat two years ago he often got under the skin of the majority Republicans who criticized him behind the scenes for sending out his personal emails they said seem more concerned with his own standing than in getting the job the township needed done.

Now he's running for committee again. We have endorsed him in the past but this time our choices are the Republicans: incumbent Dan Caffrey and running partner, Andres Benvenuto.

Caffrey is a solid bet. He's sat on the committee for the two three-year terms and has worked to make the township better in tough fiscal times.

Complaints by the Democrats that the Republicans are keeping things hidden and are doing things behind the scene rarely hold up to scrutiny. Yes, Republicans are the majority and tend to appoint fellow Republicans, but not always.

Believe it or not, they are being transparent on issues such as the Honeywell development, even as opponents say they are just parroting Honeywell's claims. They are not. What they are doing is letting Honeywell make its case for future judgment.

All the candidates in the race are attractive. Democrat Mike Kandybowicz is as appealing and articulate a 26-year-old as one is ever likely to meet.

But the balance falls to the Republicans this year and we support them.
